**NOTICE**

All Govt. /Public Sector/ Private Sector Hospitals/ Nursing Homes/ Clinics/ Laboratories/ Any Other facility providing treatment/test/investigation etc. providing treatment/services to 1000 & more patients per month are required to obtain authorization under Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 1998 notified under Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.

It is hereby brought to the notice of all health units/occupier that as per schedule II of the Bio-Medical Waste (Management & Handling) Rule 1998 the most essential part of hospital waste management is the segregation of Bio-medical waste. The segregation of the waste should be performed within the premises of the hospital/nursing homes. The color coding, type of container to be used for different waste category and suggested treatment options are listed below.

**Color Coding & Type of Container for Disposal of Bio-Medical Waste**

| Colour Coding          | Type of Containers                   | Waste Category | Treatment Option as per Schedule 1                                     |
|------------------------|--------------------------------------|----------------|--|
| Yellow                 | Plastic bag                          | 1,2,3,6        | Incineration/deep burial   |
| Red                    | Disinfected Container / Plastic bag  | 3,6,7          | Autoclaving/Micro waving/Chemicals treatment                           |
| Blue/White translucent | Plastic bag/puncture proof container | 4,7            | Autoclaving/Micro waving/Chemicals treatment and destruction/shredding |
| Black                  | Plastic bag                          | 5,9,10 (Solid) | Disposal in secured landfill   |

**Notes :**

1. Color coding of waste categories with multiple treatment options as defined in Schedule I of the Rule, shall be selected depending on treatment option chosen, which shall be as specified in Schedule 1.
2. Waste collection bags for waste types needing incineration shall not be made of chlorinated plastics.
3. Categories 8 and 10 (liquid) do not require containers/bags.
4. Category 3 if disinfected locally need not be put in Containers/bags.

In view of that they are, hereby, instructed to follow the above and submit the prescribed application in Form-I & II appended to the aforesaid Rules to the nearest Regional Office of Jharkhand State Pollution Control Board by 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2015.

**This is the last opportunity for those who have not obtained Authorization from Jharkhand State Pollution Control Board.**

**Non compliance of the aforesaid direction shall be punishable under relevant Rules & Acts including closure under section 5 & punishment under section 15 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 with imprisonment for a term which may extend to five years or with**

fine which may extend to one lakh rupees, or with both, and in case the failure or contravention continues, with additional fine which may extend to five thousand rupees for every day during which such failure or contravention continues after the conviction for the first such failure or contravention. If the failure or contravention referred above continues beyond a period of one year after the date of conviction, the offender shall be punishable with imprisonment for a term which may extend to seven years.
