Electronic Waste-Regulatory requirements

E- Waste (Management and Handling) Rules, 2011 are effective from 1st May, 2011.

Electronics Waste contains heavy metals such as Arsenic, Cadmium, Mercury, Lead etc and other toxic substances such as Polychlorinated Biphenyl's (PCBs) and chemicals etc.

Unsafe disposal of E-waste and recovery of metals from e-waste in unscientific manner pose risk to health & environment.

Regulatory requirements of producers, Bulk consumers, Dismantlers, Recyclers have been assigned in the rules.


Producers are responsible for collection of e-waste, setting up collection centers or take back systems either individually or collectively.

Producers have to ensure such e-waste are channelized to registered dismantler.

Bulk consumers listed in schedule 1 have to ensure the e-waste generated by them is channelized to authorized collection centre(s), or registered dismantlers(s) or recycler(s) or is returned to take back services.

Recycler has to obtain authorization and registration from State Pollution Control Board.
